Erasmus+ Call
for student mobility applicants
on the day of 14. 10. 2024.

General information

- **Study stay** (spring semester of the academic year 2024/2025) at a partner university abroad for one semester – for a minimum of two months,
- **Study stay** is open to all bachelor degree students,

Application and interview

- Apply via the form on the [Erasmus+ website](#) by **15. 11. 2024** and attach a short CV and a motivation letter in English. The application form will include your choice of three universities. Also register for an interview date on the [website](#) – the reservation form will appear automatically after submitting the application. Interviews will be held from **14. 10. 2024** to **15. 11. 2024**.
- The interview will be conducted in English via MS Teams. It will take about 15 minutes and we will ask you, among other things, what is your motivation for participating in the Erasmus+ programme and which universities have you chosen and why.

Evaluation criteria

A maximum of **30 points** can be obtained in the selection process:

- **motivation:** 0–10 points,
- **level of English:** 0–10 points,
- **grade point average** (over the entire course of your study to date):
 - 1.0–1.4 is 10 points,
 - 1.41–1.8 is 8 points,
 - 1.81–2.2 is 6 points,
 - 2.21–2.6 is 4 points,
 - 2.61–3.0 is 2 points,
 - 3.0 and higher is 0 points.



Nomination

- Applicants who obtain at least **15 points** will be selected (taking into account their choice of schools) to be nominated to partner universities, based on the scores of the selection procedure, the financial possibilities of the Erasmus+ grant and the exchange capacity of partner schools.
- Priority for nominations will be given to students who have not previously participated in Erasmus+ mobility in the same study cycle.

Zero grant

- Students who achieve at least 15 points in the selection procedure, but do not qualify for financial support from the Erasmus+ Programme, can still go on a study exchange abroad with the Zero grant option. This means that the student finances their own stay. All other benefits – if the mobility conditions are met – such as a free semester at AMBIS University, extended exam period, individual study plan and other administrative support remain at no additional cost to the student. The exchange student is also exempt from tuition and other scholastic fees at the partner school. The student pays for their day-to-day expenses (housing, food, transportation and so on).

Results of the selection procedure

- By **18. 11. 2024**, we will inform you by email if you have been successful in the selection process and to which university you will be nominated. Approval of the nomination is at the discretion of the partner university.
